



Dr Adli Ali is a Senior Clinical Lecturer and Consultant Paediatric Immunologist in UKM Medical Center, Malaysia. His clinical work focusses on care for patients with primary and secondary immunodysregulation disorders, autoimmune and allergy diseases.
