Dr Cecilia Poli

Dr Poli is the Director of the Program of Immunogenetics and Translational Immunology (PIGIT) at the Institute of Science and Innovation in Medicine, at Universidad del Desarrollo, Santiago, Chile. She completed a Pediatrics Residency and Rheumatology and Immunology training at Universidad de Chile. She obtained her PhD in Immunology at Baylor College of Medicine and returned to Chile where she started a research program for primary immunodeficiencies.

Dr Poli is the director of the Jeffrey Modell Center for Diagnosis and Research in Primary Immunodeficiencies at Universidad del Desarrollo and co-directs the Rare Disorders Program. Her research is focused on the discovery of novel primary immunodeficiencies with particular interest in immune dysregulation, autoimmunity and autoinflammation. On the clinical ground, she is the Chief of the Rheumatology and Immunology Unit at Hospital Roberto del Rio Paediatric Hospital.
