Dr Kohsuke Imai, a distinguished Professor at the National Defense Medical College, graduated from Tokyo Medical and Dental University in 1992. His research journey includes a PhD on Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome, groundbreaking work in Paris, and pivotal roles at NDMC and TMDU. Notable achievements involve establishing a clinical database for Primary Immunodeficiency (PIDJ) and contributing to APSID. Dr Imai's research focuses on genetic diagnosis, molecular mechanisms of immunoglobulin class switch recombination, and advancing hematopoietic stem cell transplantation and gene therapy for PID. His impactful work is evident in numerous key publications.
