



Prof Ryuta Nishikomori

Ryuta Nishikomori is a professor of Autoinflammatory section of Department of Pediatrics and Child Health, Kurume University School of Medicine. After becoming a board-certified pediatrician and finishing Kyoto University Graduate School of Medicine in 1995, he went to NIAID, National Institutes of Health to perform research on the immunological disorders such as autoimmune diseases and Primary immunodeficiency. After coming back to Kyoto University in 2001, he worked as a pediatrician on allergy and immunological diseases, especially primary immunodeficiency, autoinflammatory disorders, and pediatric rheumatology.

He has been the chairperson of the research group on autoinflammatory diseases funded by Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare since 2018 and moved to Kurume University School of Medicine in 2019. Now he is tackling to establish an organized medical practice on autoinflammatory diseases nationwide in Japan. He is also focusing more on training young doctors who can practice bench to bedside and bedside to bench.
