

## Dr Reem Elfeky

Dr Elfeky has been a Consultant in Paediatric Immunology at Great Ormond Street Hospital (GOSH), London, since 2022. She previously held consultant roles in Bone Marrow Transplantation at Bristol Children's Hospital and in Adult Immunology at the Royal Free Hospital.

She holds a Doctorate in Paediatric Immunology from Ain Shams University, Egypt, and an MD(Res) in BMT/Immunology from UCL, where she led a clinical trial on haploidentical transplantation using genetically modified T cells.

Dr Elfeky has received five international awards, including from ESID and the John Goldman Prize from BSBMT. At GOSH, she leads the CGD and post-BMT long-term follow-up services and serves as Educational Lead. She also chairs the development of guidelines on late effects post-BMT and CGD care.

Internationally, she is a Board Member for Research at ASID, where she helps develop guidelines, supports registry efforts, and organises training schools for future immunologists across Africa.
