Johan Prevot has worked in the healthcare sector for 25 years in the field of patient advocacy and health policy. Johan Prevot is the Executive Director of the International Patient Organisation for Primary Immunodeficiencies (IPOPI). As such he is responsible for the management and growth of IPOPI's global activities, awareness, and advocacy campaigns as well as the strengthening of IPOPI's national member organisations network.

Johan is currently a Board member of several other organisations including the European Reference Network on Rare Primary Immunodeficiency, Autoinflammatory and Autoimmune diseases (ERN-RITA) and the AGORA Foundation (Access to Gene Therapies for Rare Diseases). He is also a Steering Committee Member of the Platform of Plasma Products Users (PLUS), and Screen4Rare (newborn screening multi stakeholder platform).

He has throughout his career been an advocate for improving patient access to early diagnosis and treatment in the field of primary immunodeficiencies and other rare plasma related disorders. He has also been an advocate for promoting equitable access to newborn screening and played a key role in the launch of the International Neonatal Screening Day (INSD). He has and continues to work closely with other stakeholder organisations sharing common objectives and priorities.
